From Abdelaziz Onkoud I received 39 anonymous entries. Two of them was cooked. Surprisingly many good problems, here my award :

1 Prize Nr 3 At least for me a big surprise! After five moves have wKa1 and wBb2 change place! Also blacks play are unusual. Dg2-d5-f7 and Lh1- d5-e6.

2 Prize Nr 29 Rundlauf of bBd5 and Rehm theme. Economical and no capture before the mate. Minimal.

3 Prize Nr 34 Minimal, Rehm theme. wBf2 and bBg1 change place before the model mates. Meredith.

4 Prize Nr 16 A nice problem. Active Zilahi, echo model mates. Meredith

5 Prize Nr 38 Interesting play of bQ and bB. Minimal, Meredith and models.

1 HM Nr 25 Excelsior, models, Meredith and interesting tempo play. A little disadvantage is that the first three moves a nearly forced.

2 HM Nr 39 I think that the tries in blacks first move can be a news. Exactly analogous solutions.

3 HM Nr 31 To blocks on b7 and b8, black must play exactly in his first move. 1Tb3?, 1Tb2? 1Tb1! Nice and unusal.

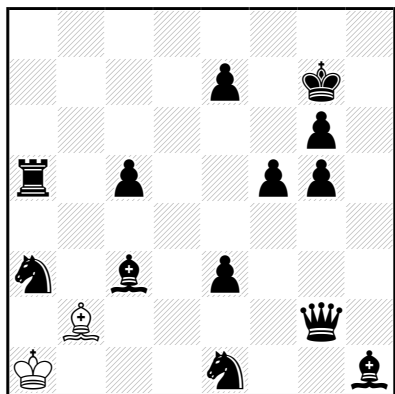
4HM Nr 32 Precision work where the author has used the black pieces well.

5 HM Nr 28 Nice long moves of both Bishops. No capture, Meredith, models.
